

## PRACTICAL INFO BASIC & ADVANCED TRAINING

When you enter the Circuit Zolder through the tunnel, follow the road to the left. Keep driving until you see the first motorcycles parked. From there, you can park your car with a trailer or your van. The area is large enough, so you'll find a spot. If you come by motorcycle, keep driving until you reach the back of the pit boxes. Behind the "newest" pit boxes, you will see the flags of Motorsportschool Zolder at pit box 34. There is also plenty of space to park your motorcycle and then check in.

- Once you are parked, head into pit box 35 and check in at the right desk.
- Have your ID card ready, as it will serve as collateral for your transponder.
- Wait calmly for your turn and then check in with Hans or Niels.
- Upon registration, you will receive the following items:
  - a transponder with a transponder holder
  - a starting number (on the back of these stickers, we also write your starting number)
  - a BASIC or ADVANCED sticker
  - a detailed schedule (which you have also received via email)

Once you are registered and have received all these items, you should...

- Place the transponder holder and transponder <u>on your motorcycle's fuel tank</u>. The holder has double-sided Velcro, making it easy to attach.
- Stick your starting number, along with the BASIC or ADVANCED sticker, to the front of your motorcycle. It is important that the BASIC or ADVANCED sticker is clearly visible.
- Once everything is in order, take your motorcycle to the technical inspection at pit box 39.
  NOTE!!! The motorcycles must remain in the pit lane all day. Make sure your motorcycle is fully fueled before heading to the technical inspection. Refueling is available at the circuit, just past the Otobar.
- Pit box 39 is only 15 meters away from the registration desk. Here, we will check the condition of your motorcycle. We mainly inspect the brake pads, tires, and exhaust. If everything is ok, you will receive an OK sticker from the technical inspection.
- After the technical inspection, exit pit box 39 and ride to the **LEFT** into the pit lane. A little further down, the pit lane crew of Motorsportschool Zolder will be waiting to assign you a spot for your motorcycle.
- The BASIC and ADVANCED groups are set up separately in the pit lane.
- Once your motorcycle is properly positioned, you don't need to do anything else until the briefing.
- The ADVANCED briefing starts **PROMPTLY** at 8:40 a.m. The BASIC briefing starts **PROMPTLY** at 9:15 a.m.
- Attend the briefing in your motorcycle gear and bring your gloves and helmet. After the briefing, we will immediately get ready to ride.
